
## Notes

- 1. The main subject of interest of the project is chess because it is the ideal game to exercise most of the multiple intelligences (abilities).
- 2. The chess contents in the learning material make up only 10% of the total contents and can be taught by teaching staff without previous chess knowledge.
- 3. The contents can be broadened and updated with the collaboration of schools from around the world through the use of the eTwinning platform.
- 4. The project specially promotes learning in minority languages and/or practicing other languages.
- 5. In general, the linguistic and mathematical intelligences make up the base of traditional education. This project contributes to the change of the educational model as it strengthens the rest of the intelligences too. For example, emotional education.

The Play and Learn learning material is intended to contribute to the **comprehensive education** of pupils in primary schools (6 to 12 years old) through the model of the Theory of Multiple Intelligences.

Howard Gardner defines intelligence as the "ability to solve problems or make products that are important in one or more cultures."

To succeed in business or in sport it is necessary to be intelligent, but a different kind of intelligence is used in each field.



One way of contributing to a multiple intelligences education consists in designing a model programme based on a main subject of interest and developing the adequate learning material.
