Solidarity project

This solidarity project is inspired on the idea 'Teaming', which allows everybody to collaborate in generating resources to finance projects of NGOs in any country.

We want to collaborate from the educational and ludic spheres following the solidarity model Teaming (www.teaming.info).

Due to the feature that all multilingual materials (books in PDF format, multimedia through INTERNET, videos, etc.) will be accesible free of charge, the proposal will be made that educational centres, civic centres, etc. make economic contributions to finance solidarity projects (the own organization collects the money, choose the destination and carries out the donation directly, without intervention of any intermediaries).

Later on, when we have the possibility to offer free of charge the interactive activities, games and contest through the Internet website, it will be possible for the users to donate 1 Euro through a SMS message, to a previously selected NGO for financing a solidarity project.

Our Association will not obtain any economic benefit from these solidarity actions.

Summing up, there is the aim of creating a state of opinion which favours that persons who have the possibility to enjoy a ludic education and training, show solidarity toward others who have not had the same opportunities, through micro-donations derived from the free use of high quality educational, sports and ludic materials.
