This project, created by all and for all, encourages cooperation with other proposals or integration with them, with the aim of exponentially multiplying the reach and impact of its goals.

The success of the other five subprojects will act as a driving force to stimulate and consolidate the growth of the sports subproject.

Mission Promote the universalization of chess through the implementation of **educational chess**¹ in schools.

Become a global benchmark in educational chess by developing a multilingual platform (**WikiChess 3.0**)² that guarantees universal and free access to **educational resources**³ and to the **Educachess School Contest**⁴.
